Notes for Exhibitors

- 1. All exhibits, except for Decorative Classes, must come from plants grown by the exhibitor for at least 3 months.
- 2. There are no entry fees.
- 3. Entries may be benched Friday 7:30 pm 9 pm and Saturday 7:30 am 11:00 am.
- 4. Containers are provided, except for classes 149 154.
- 5. Exhibitors must leave the hall before the judging starts.
- 6. Exhibits are to be accompanied by a completed entry card, showing the name(s) of the cultivar(s) (if known).
- 7. Exhibits, certificates & trophies are not to be removed until the close of the Show on Sunday.
- 8. Potential Champion blooms would be best entered as individual blooms rather than in collections.
- 9. At the discretion of the judges, certificates will be awarded for 1st and 2nd in each class and for Highly Commended entries, for the Best Exhibit of each "section", various Champions based on form, etc. and for the Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion.

Some Important Definitions

<u>Single</u>: A maximum of eight petals in a single row, with an uninterrupted cluster of stamens.

<u>Semi-Double</u>: Two or more rows of petals, with an uninterrupted cluster of stamens.

<u>Irregular Semi-Double</u>: A semi-double, but with an interrupted cluster of stamens.

<u>Formal Double</u>: Any number of petals, regularly disposed, tiered or imbricated, but no visible stamens.

<u>Informal Double</u>: A Double with any number of petals and petaloids. Stamens may or may not be visible.

<u>Elegans Form Double</u>: An Informal Double with one or more rows of large outer petals lying flat or undulating; the centre a convex mass of intermingled petaloids and stamens.




